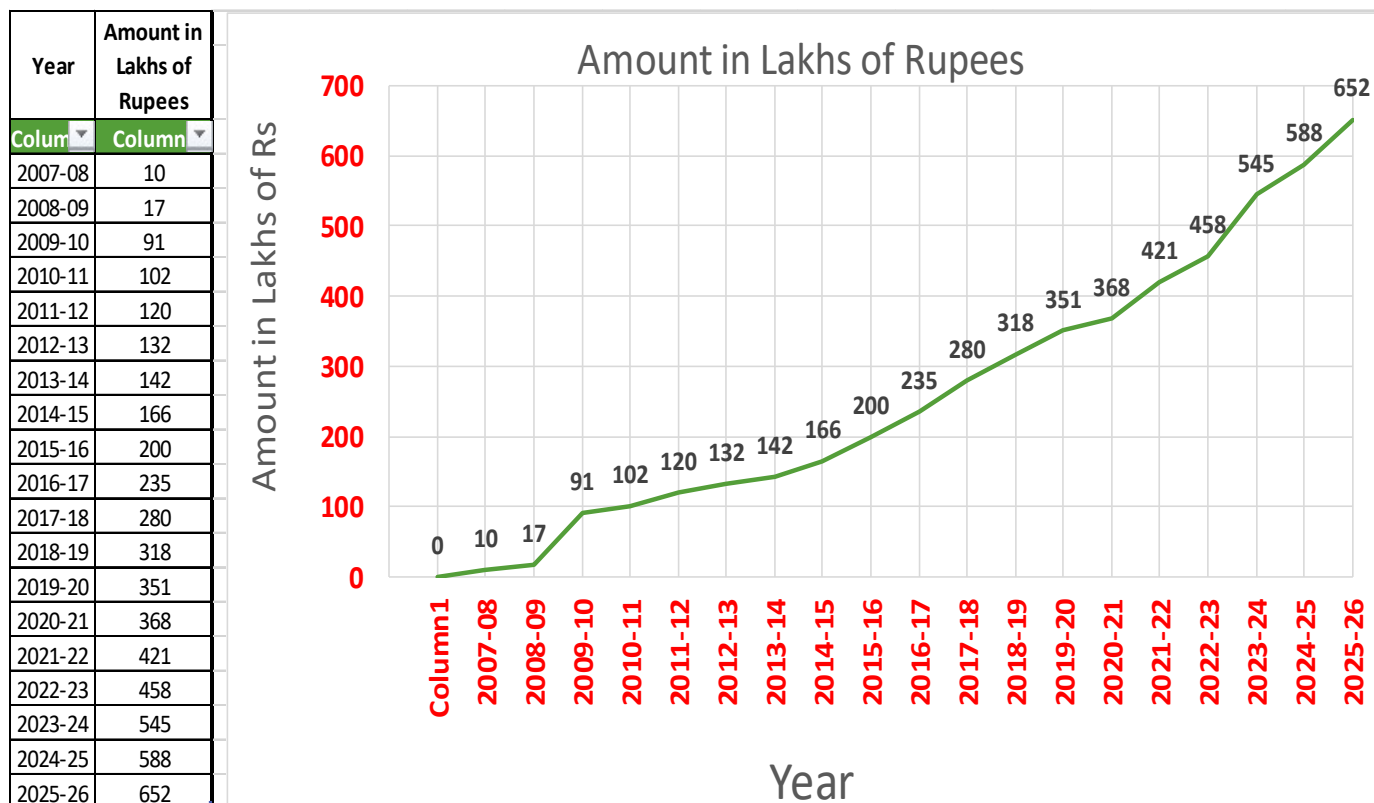

AMITA Trust Corpus Fund Growth

Since its initial launch in 2006 with a modest capital pool of INR 10 Lakhs, the trust has grown remarkably thanks to consistent alumni donations. The permanent capital corpus has now reached an outstanding total of INR 6.52 Crores. During the 2025-26 fiscal window alone, we secured INR 75,33,269 from global contributors, all of which was safely locked into fixed deposit investments. As of March 31, 2026, the available cash balance at the bank stands at INR 16,23,028.

AMITA Trust Fund Growth – Curve over the Years

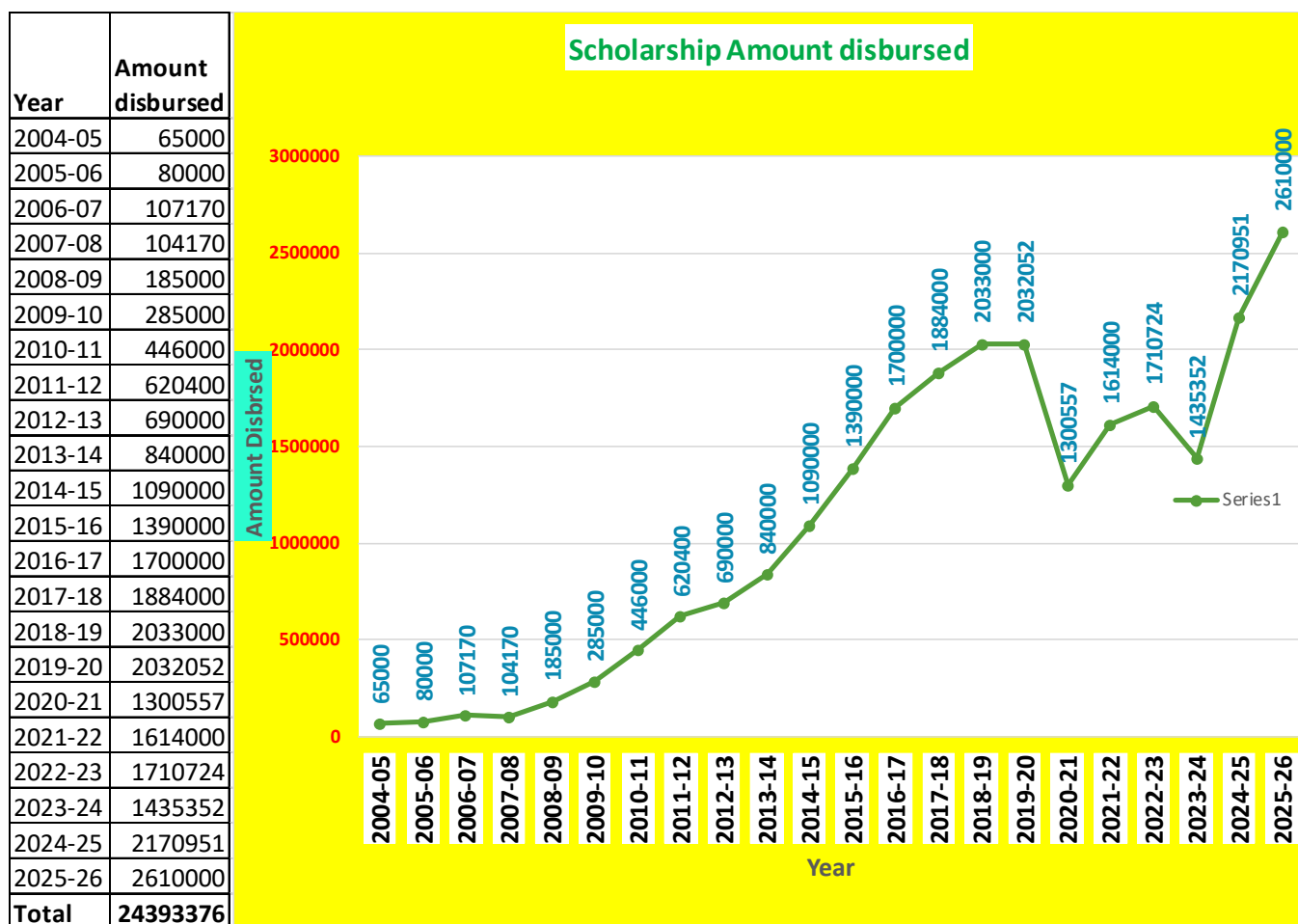
Here's a graphical representation of the corpus fund growth. MITAA is happy to announce that the trust corpus stands at INR 6.52 Crores. This was made possible from the generous contribution from over 600 alumni across the globe and the rent less efforts of the members of Alumni Association



The corpus fund is put in fixed deposits. The interest earned is disbursed towards student scholarships. This FY, the interests received was about INR 40,97,793 /-.

Scholarship Amount Disbursed Over the Years

For this year, a total of about 102 scholarships were distributed. The scholarships given were worth about INR 26,10,000 in total.

Renewal of Scholarships distributed to 62 (60 UG + 2 PG) students of 2nd to 4th year on 23rd December '25. After the distribution of scholarship cheques, MITAA had a good interaction with these students.

Scholarships for the fresh students was distributed to 40 students (38 UG+2PG) on 23rd March 2026.

UG students were given Rs 25,000/ each and PG students were given Rs 40,000/ each. Apart from Scholarships, eight 2nd year students were given Rs 10 K as Cash Prize Award for those who scored high in their First-year exams. This is from the corpus created by the 47th batch alumni.

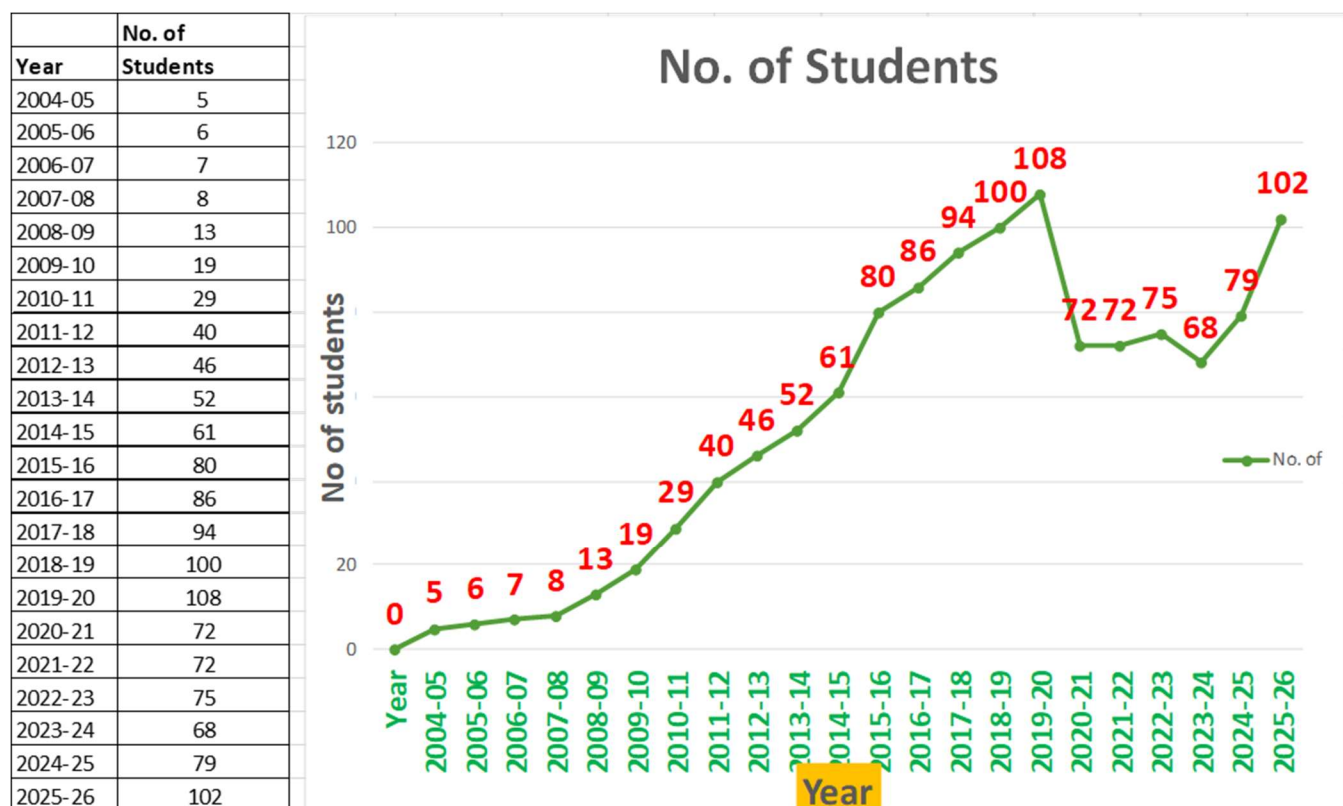
Best performing 5 students from the Final year were given Rs 10K each Cash Award sponsored by the 32nd batch Alumni

Since beginning, in all 1222 scholarships have been distributed. The average stands at about INR 1,00,000/- per student spread over four years.

Loan for higher studies:

MITAA is extending financial support for higher education abroad for MIT students by way of interest free loan. So far Two students were given Interest free loans. One student completed his studies and started to repay. The other student is studying.

Aid from Foundation for Excellence

We extend our deepest gratitude to Mrs. Usha Balaji, and Mr. N. Ramachandran for their tireless efforts in securing extensive funding from the American Foundation for Excellence - FFE. This year, 165 incoming fresh students received substantial grants of Rs. 50,000 each, pouring a transformative total of Rs. 82,50,000 into our student body. These vital financial lifelines will continue throughout their entire four years of study, provided they maintain solid academic standings. Since introducing the FFE program, 2,024 MIT students have benefited from a total funding pool of INR 7.52 Crores, with half a dozen of our own alumni actively serving as local facilitators and career mentors.

Book Bank

Today, MITAA book bank has approximately 2640 books and the department libraries have more than 900 books. About 400 students of all the faculties, PG and research associates are benefitted by it.

Books for GRE, TOFEL, GATE and ILTS, DRDL, ISRO exams and interviews are also available in book bank. MITAA has donated ISA Standards books to MIT E & I library. Books to develop English knowledge for Tamil Medium students are also available. Audio and video CDs are also available for the students in this regard.

General knowledge enhancement books for competitive exams for final year students are available in Book Bank.

More than 100 MIT Alumni have donated books valued close to INR 22.5 Lakhs in total and all are being circulated free of cost to students.

Mr. Maria Antony T. No 46231, our EC Member coordinates this activity.

This year 72 Books were purchased by AMITA Trust for a Value Rs 50,780/ and donated to MIT Library

ALUMNI CENTRE: Skill Development Centre

A new 'Skill Development cum Alumni Centre' will be built in the place of the existing Alumni House that was constructed more than 50 years ago, Infront of Hangar-I.

The Centre will have three floors. The facilities include a Conference Hall with all accessories to conduct skill set trainings, a Meeting Hall that can be used to conduct virtual meetings, an office room and guest rooms for the visiting Alumni.

MITAA put up a proposal to the Syndicate of Anna University which in turn, had given approval to go ahead. Soil test has been completed; Design of the building is finalized and the Negotiation with the Contractors is going on.

An amount of Rs 67 Lakhs has been collected so far

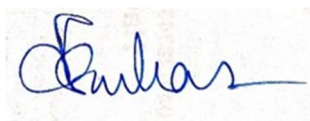
